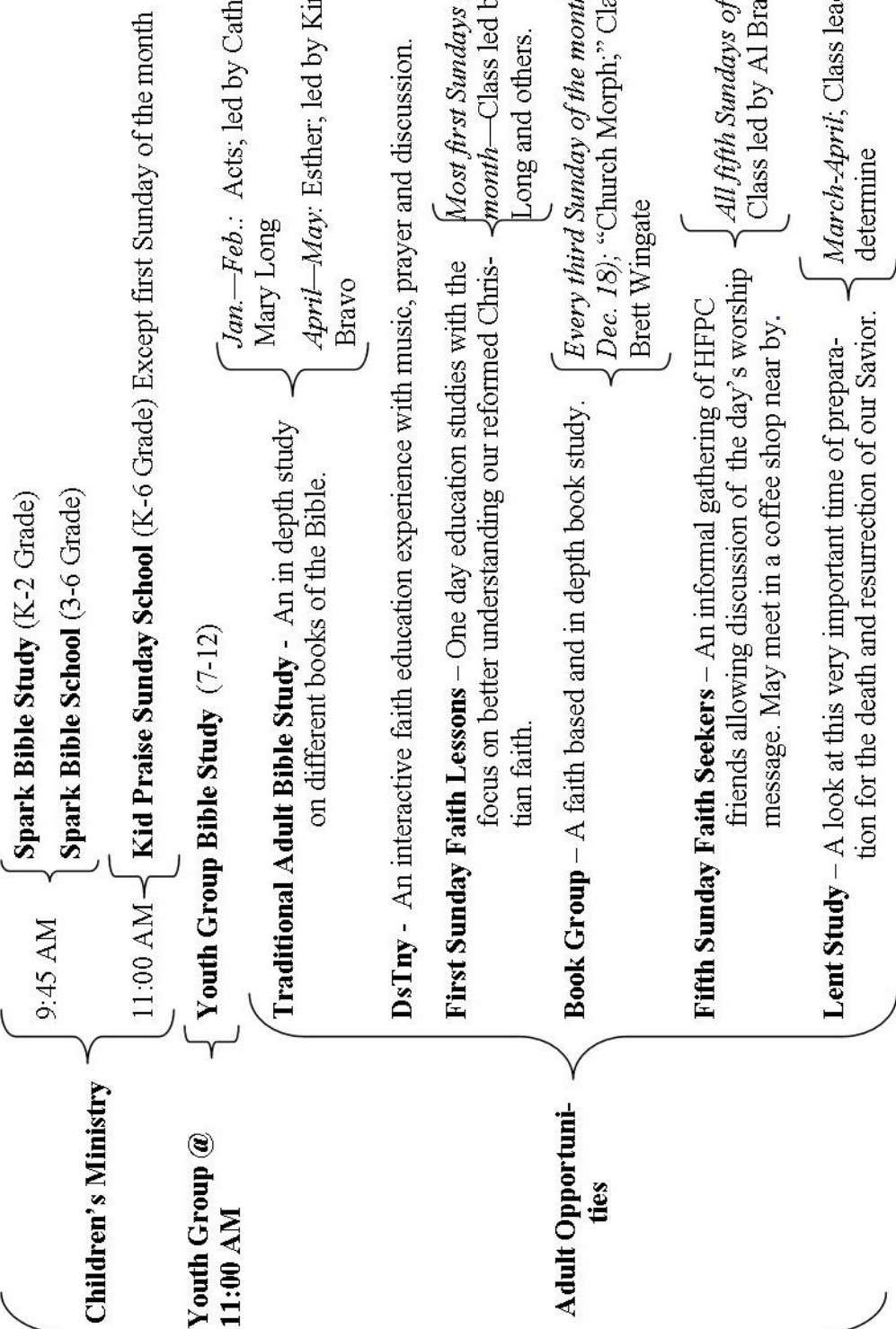

All fifth Sundays of the month—Class led by Al Bravo

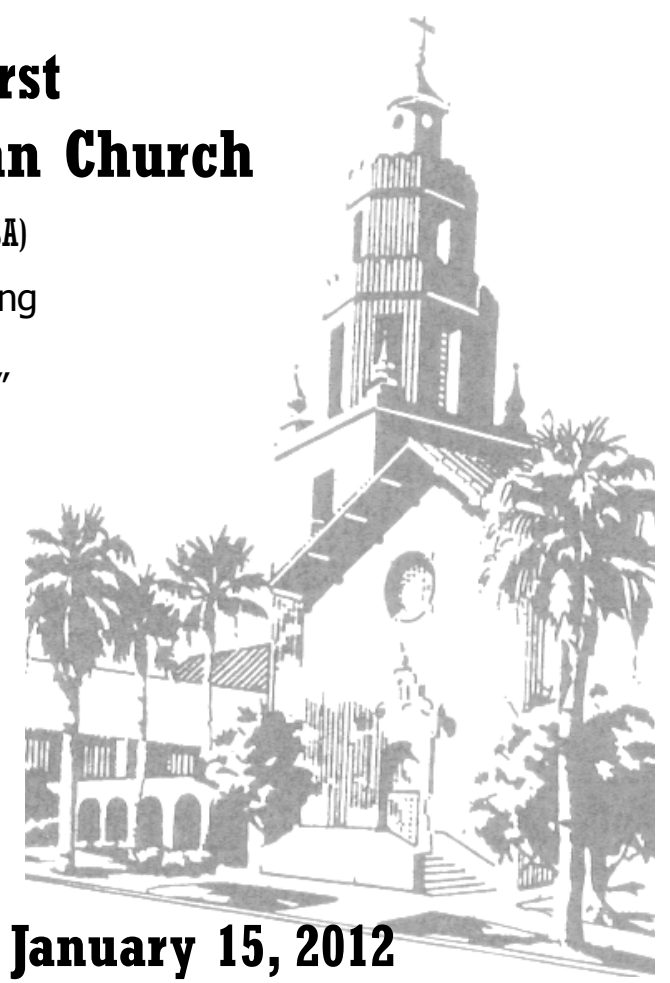

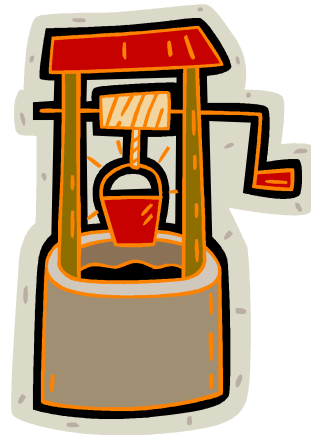
