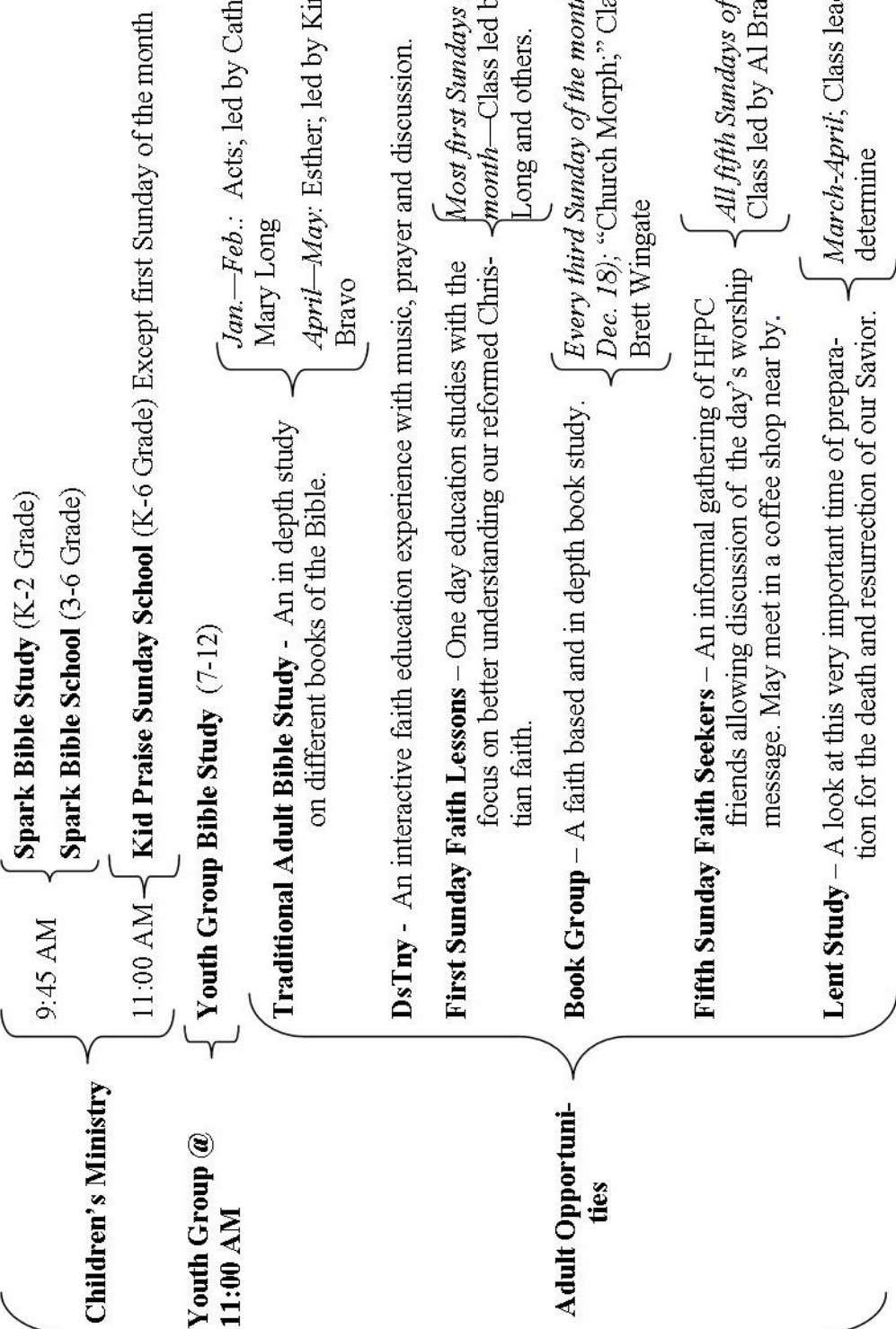

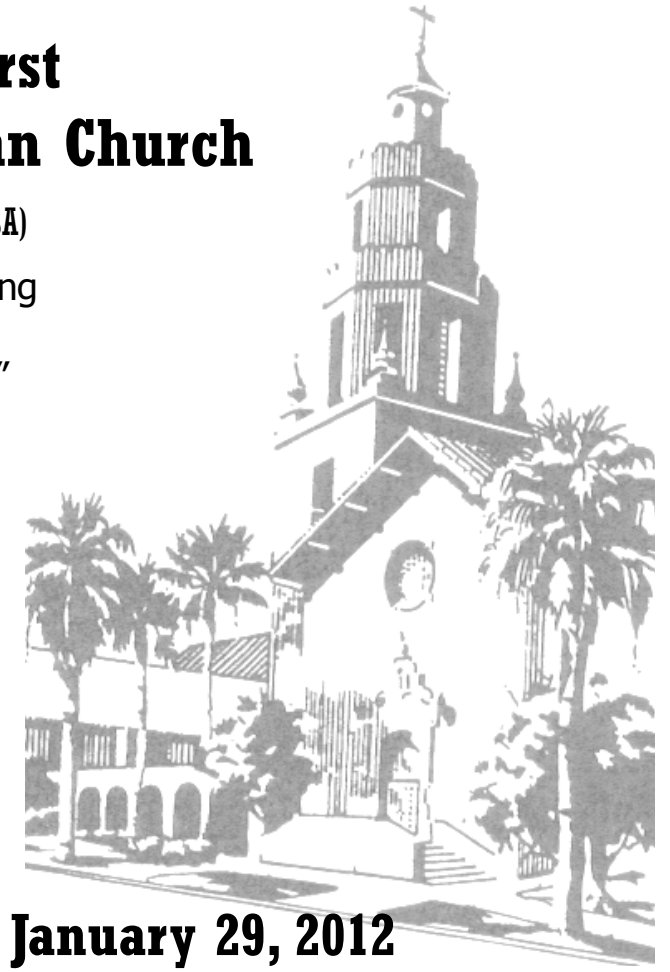

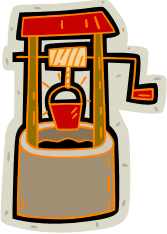

2012 SOUPER BOWL OF CARING OFFERING NEXT SUNDAY

In 1990, a simple pastoral prayer inspired a youth-led movement to feed the hungry. That prayer was, "Lord, even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us to be mindful of those who are without a bowl of soup to eat". That movement became known as the "Souper Bowl of caring. Its mission is to utilize Super Bowl Sunday to inspire and mobilize youth to fight hunger and poverty. The "Souper Bowl" is a simple effort to "love the Lord our God and love our neighbors" by encouraging people to give \$1.00 each as they leave worship on Super Bowl Sunday.

Once again, HFPC's children and youth will participate in this mission on **February 5, 2012**. The youth will be at the doors after worship with collection baskets.
