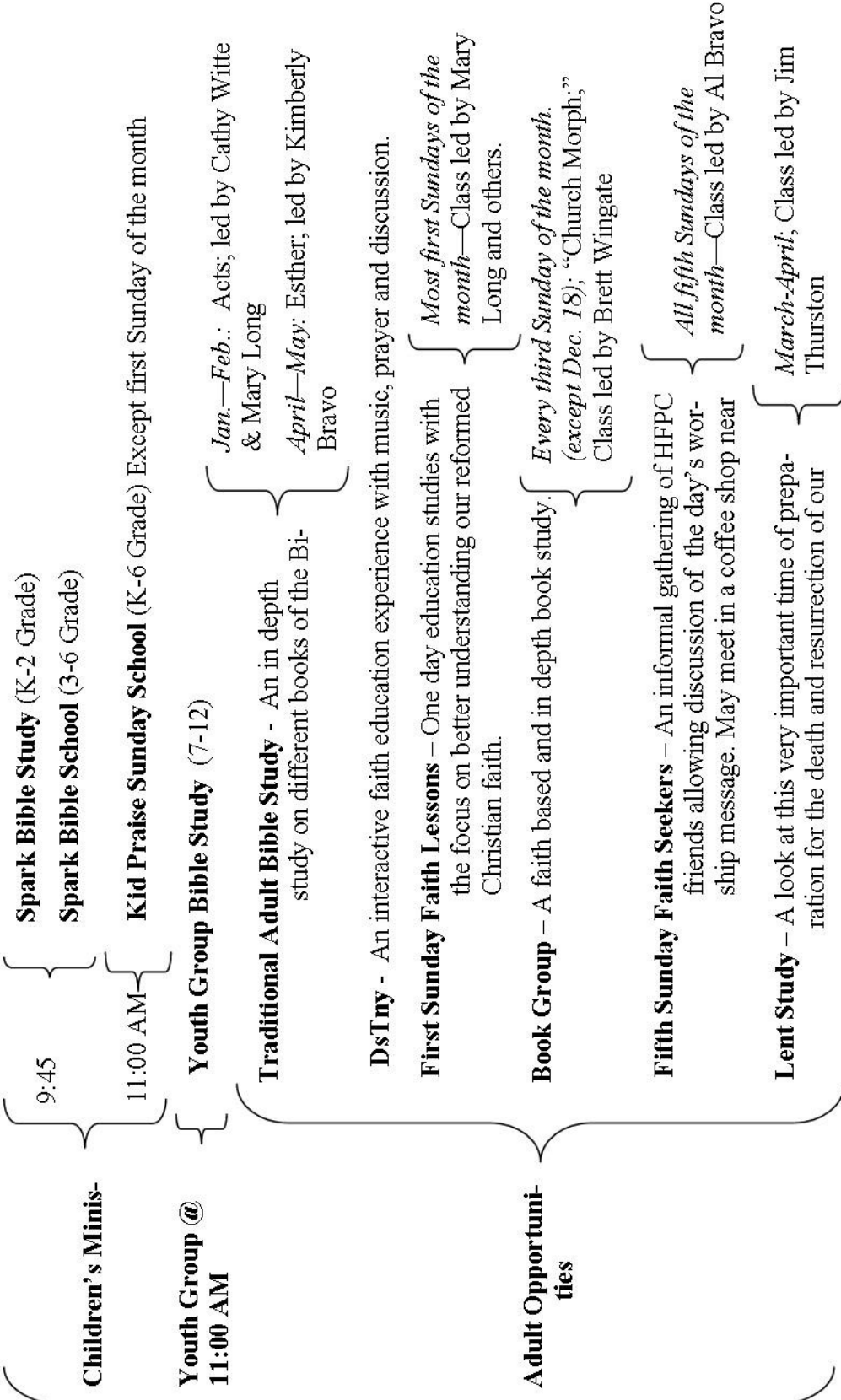

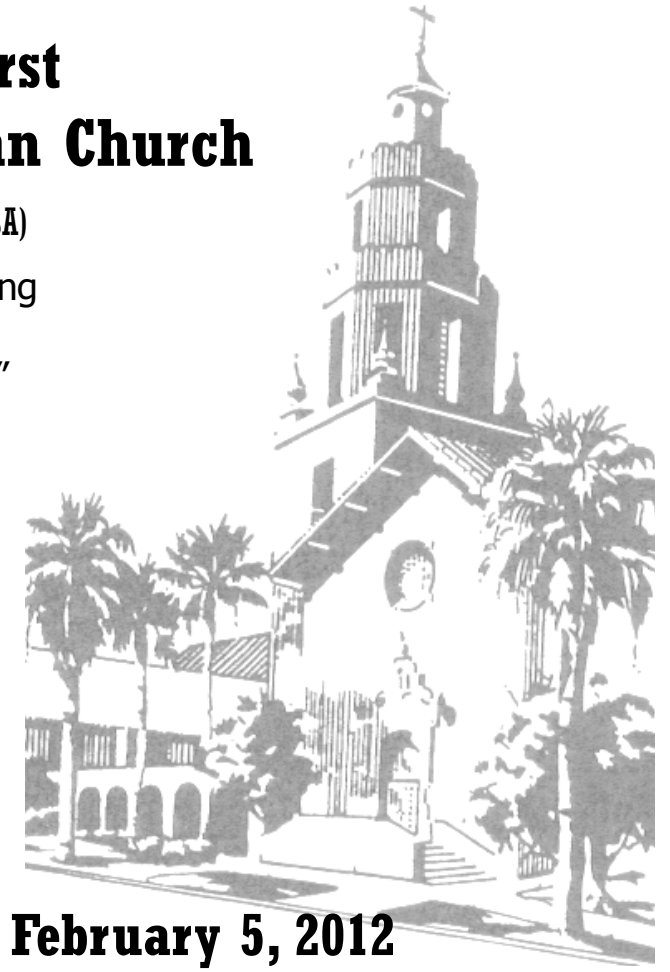

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD/SHOE BOX MINISTRY NEEDS YOU!

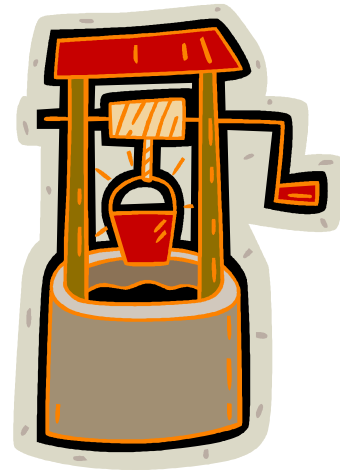
